DAY ONE PROGRAM

Saturday 19th August 2017 9.00am – 4.30pm



DI FORD HALL – Giggleswick Mill Sampler (Code: SAT1)

Di has a brand new quilt from her new book "Primarily Quilts...2". Giggleswick Mill Sampler has a variety of different styles of applique blocks to discover in this quilt. Learn how to make different blocks that are part of this magnificent new project.



WENDY WILLIAMS – Pick of The Bunch (Code: SAT2)

This is a relatively quick quilt to make, I also will have an option for it to be a pillow. Learn some simple wool felt applique techniques as well as dimensional needle turn. I will discuss design layout and choosing colours and background fabrics.



RAYLENE RICHARDSON – White Nights (Code: SAT3)

Join Raylene with building blocks for design and create your original "WHITE NIGHTS". Using fabric, paint and stitching to create an great effect, as well as over painting.



VICKI JENKIN – Fill it With Feathers (Code: SAT4)

Feathers are so versatile, they can be used to fill almost any shape, and *shhh...* don't tell anyone... but they aren't hard to do, once you know how! A free motion quilting class which teaches feather anatomy and techniques for filling any space with feathers.

A basic amount of freemotion quilting knowledge and experience is required.



MICHELLE YEO - Georgetown Circle (Code: SAT5)

This class is a great technique class to learn foundation piecing, using freezer paper, as well as curved piecing. Students will be provided with the pattern for the foundation and templates for a single block. The Georgetown Circle Quilt consists of four of these traditional Georgetown Circle blocks competed with a single border.

DI FORD HALL – Let The Fabric Do the Work (Code: SUN1)

This is a <u>NEW</u> project that Di is currently designing, containing Birds, Wreaths, Hexagon and Pentagon flowers. It is suitable for reproduction or modern fabrics. You will work on the centre block and Di will guide you through the design process, needleturn applique techniques and Broderie Perse.

WENDY WILLIAMS – Feather Pillow (Code: SUN2)

This cushion is designed to give you an insight into the different stitches I use in my wool applique, it is like a little sampler. We will do as many of my stitches and applique techniques as we can get through in one day.



RAYLENE RICHARDSON – Shake Your Tail Feather (Code: SUN3) Design your own fantasy-feathered friend using fabric, paint and stitching in



JULIE ADAMSON – Hand Applique Precious Paisley (Code: SUN4)

This small quilt, with its interlocking paisleys and fine detail is a delight to work on and far easier to accomplish than it appears.

Learning and/or refining needleturn technique is a major component of this class. The overall design could be kept quite simple and classic or heavily detailed depending on skill level or taste.



JUDY NEWMAN - MayFair Quilt (Code: SUN5)

Mayfair is a colourful eclectic quilt consisting of 16 large blocks with a consistent check/stripe and shot cottons forming a secondary pattern in the corners. It is made using acrylic templates which will be available for purchase in class. Alternatively, you may wish to cut your own templates using templastic, either is fine.
