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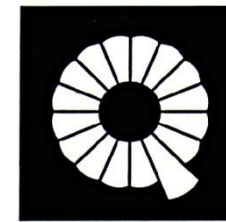

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This exhibition is open to quilt makers residing in Australia.
2. All entries must be original and not subject to copyright in any form. The work must not be the product of an instructional setting.
3. Your entry must not have been previously exhibited in Australia.
4. Quilts will be selected and judged on their interpretation of the theme "Metamorphosis", as well as their originality, design, technique and craftsmanship. Quilts may be pictorial, geometric, abstract, machine or hand pieced and quilted.
5. It does not matter what shape the quilt is as long as the circumference is not larger than 6 metres or smaller than 2.5 metres. The width of the quilt must not exceed 1.5 metres at its widest. A quilt must consist of 2 or more layers visibly stitched together.
6. Each entrant may submit up to 2 quilts. Each quilt or composite set of quilts forming one exhibit is regarded as a separate entry and must be accompanied by all the items listed in the entry requirements.
7. The winning quilt is, if possible, to be made available for public display and be available to AQA on request for their 2020 Members' exhibition.
8. Selection for exhibition will be made from two good-quality photographs per quilt. One photo of the full quilt must show all edges of the finished quilt. The second photo must show the detail of a section of the quilt. Each photo should show on the back the quilter's name, name and size of the quilt and an arrow to indicate the top of the quilt. The photos must be of **completed** quilts.
9. Quilts selected for exhibition will be chosen by a jury panel and then the final exhibition will be judged. The judges' decision will be final. No discussion or correspondence regarding the initial selection or judging will be entered into.

10. Each entry must have its own entry form and be accompanied by the maker's statement and a \$25.00 entry fee.

12. Receipt of entry forms will be acknowledged. After jurying, all entrants will be notified of the result and, if accepted for exhibition, delivery and return instructions for the quilts will be sent.

13. Quilts must be received ready to exhibit. All quilts must have a label firmly attached to the back detailing your name and address and the title of the quilt. A hanging sleeve with a finished depth of 10cm must be attached to the back of each quilt. If the quilt is of very light structure the hanging pocket should be stiffened to ensure the quilt stays in the intended position. The sleeve should be 2.5cm from the side edges of the quilt and 1.5cm from the top.

14. Entrants whose quilts are selected for exhibition will be responsible for the cost of packing, shipping and transit **TO** and **FROM** the organisers' premises. The quilt must be packed in a strong re-usable container sent by **registered post** or hand-delivered.

15. The organisers [AQA] will be responsible for security and insurance of each quilt upon reception by AQA (up to the value of \$2,000). This covers storage in the organisers' premises and transit to and from the venue. Whilst on show the quilts will be covered by the Gallery's insurance.

16. The organisers reserve the right to photograph or permit to be photographed all quilts to be exhibited. These photographs may be used for publicity or other appropriate purposes. Photography by the public **for personal** use is permitted in the Whitehorse Artspace.

17. The organisers reserve the right to hang or not hang any quilt.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For each entry you will need to send the following:

1. A completed entry form (please photocopy the original form for multiple entries).
2. An attached cheque or money order for \$25.00 per entry made payable to AQA - AQIPP EXHIBITION.
3. Artist's Statement no more than 50 words. On a separate sheet, please write about how your quilt interprets the Australian Quilts in Public Places theme. If your quilt is selected for exhibition, your statement will form part of your exhibit. Attach your Artist's Statement to the entry form.
4. Two photographs of the quilt as specified under Conditions of Entry.
5. A stamped and self-addressed business-size envelope for notification of acceptance.
6. Please use a black pen and capitals on the entry form. [Note - email address is case sensitive]
